Thanks to the prompt and coordinated response from Brad's teammates, opposition, BMTA staff, and on-site first aid personnel, he received immediate care.

We've been in regular contact with Brad and his family, who have kindly allowed us to share that he is recovering well.

We extend our deepest gratitude to everyone involved for their swift and life-saving actions. Your response reflects the best of our BMTA community.

Our thoughts and best wishes are with Brad, his family, and loved ones during this time. We hope to see Brad back at the BMTA fields soon.

This event underscores the importance of first aid and emergency preparedness, and we encourage everyone to consider completing first aid + CPR training and how you can be best prepared to respond in an emergency.
